

How to enter in allergies and hypersensitivities in Avatar


- 1. In the search bar start typing in "allergy" and a pop-up box will appear with forms that match the letters you entered
- 2. Select "Allergies and Hypersensitivities




- 3. In the select client window search for the appropriate individual either by last name or avatar #
  - a. Select the appropriate individual in the search results



4. In the main Allergies and Hypersensitivities screen, click on "display" to review if there are any allergies and hypersensitivities entered for the individual




a. A report will be generated (it takes a moment) and it will list any allergies or hypersensitivities that have been entered




- b. Review the listings to make sure it is correct and then click on the "X" in the upper right corner to close
- c. After closing the report where you reviewed the allergy information, click yes in the Allergies/Hypersensitivities reviewed
- 5. In the Known Medication Allergies section, mark yes or no if there is a known MEDICATION allergy or hypersensitivity


- a. Note: this is just for MEDICATION not all allergies
- 6. Click on Update to go to the screen to enter in any known or suspected allergies/hypersensitivities




- 7. Enter in all known or suspected allergies or hypersensitivities
  - a. If there are not any rows of data entered, that means that no information has been entered



- 8. Click on "New Row" to add each applicable allergy
  - a. A new row will appear and the allergen/reactant field will highlight in yellow
- 9. Enter in the appropriate information. The required fields will be outlined in red if needed but still blank
  - a. Avatar can assist in filling in the information. Start typing the first few letters of the appropriate response then press tab to advance to the next field. A pop-up will appear with choices that match what was entered
  - b. NOTE: Not all brand names of medications are in the system. For example, you cannot find Tylenol, try searching for Acetaminophen




c. For the status there are 3 options: Confirmed, Discontinued, Suspected



d. For the reaction, if you are entering in NKA or No Known Allergies there is an option for "No Reaction"



- 10. After all allergies are entered, click on "Save" and you will be returned to the main allergies and hypersensitivities screen
- 11. To double check that your entries are in Avatar and that you didn't accidently not enter in anything, it is a best practice to click on "Display" again to view all of the allergies



12. Click on submit after everything is entered
